

## **DECLARATION USED AT TRUMPET CALL II: 18 June 2005**

We make declaration that Jesus has been appointed by God to be Heir of all things, through whom also He made the ages. Hebrews 1:2

We also declare that Jesus, being the express image of God, upholds all things by the word of His power, having sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high. Hebrews 1:3

We make declaration into the heavenly realm, according to Colossians 2:9 and 10, that "In Jesus dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily and we are complete in Him who is the Head of all principality and power."

The law came through Moses, grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. John 1:17.

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of His grace that He lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding. Ephesians 1:7-8.

We also declare into the heavenly realm that the Lord will deliver us from every evil work and preserve us for His heavenly Kingdom.

We also declare that according to 1 Corinthians 6:19, through the blood of Jesus our bodies are temples of the living God.

We declare that through the blood of Jesus we are seated with Him, who is at the right hand of God the Father in the heavenly realms, far above all principality and power and might and dominion and every name that is named not only in this age but also in that which is to come. Ephesians 1:20

And He put all things under His feet and gave Him to be Head over all things for the Church which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.
